For this week, I had completed some of the necessary things to be done. I met up with my uncle who owns a printing firm and he is willing to print my inserts at zero-profit. (If you go to outside printer, they may charge you at about 80cents per insert)

Inserts are the little piece of paper in between the wedding invitation cards:

Below are the 11 info you need to fill in before you go to the printer:

- 1) couples names in Chinese and English
- 2) couples' parents names in Chinese and Mandarin
- 3) Hotel's ballroom in Chinese and English, inclusive of address in both languages
- 4) time the guests are expected to arrive
- 5) couples' email address and contacts
- 6) wedding date according to lunar calendar
- 7) Date to R.S.V.P
- 8) material of paper (e.g. tracing paper, translucent...)
- 9) type of stamping (hot stamping...)
- 10) color of print (gold, silver...)
